



From the Secretary's Desk

Brethren, up until a few months ago, the Lodge's money was tied up in time deposits and money market accounts. We were making very little interest on our money --- approximately \$ 1,700.00 a year on approximately \$ 400,000.00.

In May of this year we invested \$350,000.00 with O'connell Wealth Management Group. They have invested our money in 13 separate entities. At the end of August 2014, the value of our account was \$361,233.59. A gain of over \$11,000.00.

We realize there may be months that do not do well, July for instance, was a bad month—we lost \$ 3,600 +/- but over the long term, we expect to do much better than the time deposits and money markets.

This is your money brethren, if anyone would like further information, such as the names of the entities we are invested in, etc., I have a list of all 13 and how each individual one is doing month by month. Let me know, I can get you the information.

I will give updates in the Trestleboard from time to time and also at the Stated Meetings every quarter.
