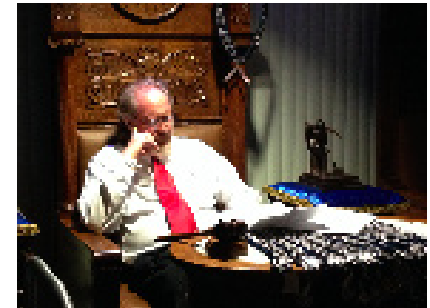

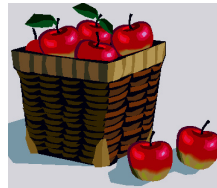

## Greetings from the West



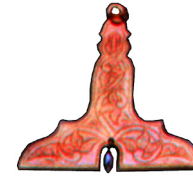
What a month we had in August! Stated meeting dinner was a huge success as our Job's Daughters cooked and served dinner. We also preformed both a first and second degree this month!
