





Greetings from the South



Sometimes we forget that the Holy Bible is a distinctively "Masonic Document"; not only because it chronicles the works of King Solomon, King Hiram of Tyre, AND Hiram the "widows son", in building the Temple of God, but ALSO because it is filled (from beginning to end) with uniquely "Masonic" symbolism.

Isaiah (for instance) alludes to the many tools of the builders art: "The carpenter stretcheth out his RULE; he marketh it out with a LINE; he fitteth it with PLANES, and he marketh it out with the COMPASS" (Isaiah 44:13).

The prophet Amos stated that in vision he saw "the Lord" with the Masonic "plumbline in his hand". He wrote : "Thus he shewed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall made by a PLUMBLINE, with a plumbline in his hand. And the LORD said unto me, Amos, what seest thou? And I said, a plumbline. Then said the Lord, Behold, I will set a plumbline in the midst of my people Israel: I will not again pass by them any more". (Amos 7:7, 8) Clearly, the "plumbline" in this instance was the symbolic measure used by God to determine the uprightness of the people.

According to Jeremiah, individuals who failed to live up to sacred obligations contracted in the Temple, were promised that "their dead bodies shall be for meat unto the fowls of the heaven, and to the beasts of the earth". (see Jeremiah 34:15-20)

Finally, the Apostle Peter make the analogy complete by referring to certain disciples as being LIVING "stones". He wrote: "Ye also, as lively ("living") stones, are built up a spiritual house". (see 1 Peter 2:4, 5)

Many more examples could be cited to demonstrate the peculiarly "Masonic" nature of the Bible. The above examples are given in the sincere hope that each of us (regardless of personal religion or faith) will turn to that great fund of wisdom contained within the pages of the Holy Writings. As a Masonic Document, ALL Masons (Christian, Jew, Muslim, Sikh, or Deist) may find within its pages Wisdom sufficient to guide us in our walk as Freemasons. May the Great Architect of the Universe find us so walking is my prayer.

For the month of May, our Stated Meeting dinner will be a "Taco Bar". Hope to see all of you there!
