Symbols of the Craft

The Setting Maul vs. the Gavel

The Setting Maul is a crude wooden hammer used by Operative Masons to set the stones in their proper position in the mortar. This simple tool is one of the most important symbols in Speculative Masonry as it reminds us of integrity and the frailty of life.

The Gavel in its purest form is actually an iron axe or pick, having a steel edge or point, with which the quarryman roughly trims the stone. In a speculative sense, the trimming of a stone could mean the improvement of the mind and conscience, for the betterment of man and God.

The uses of the gavel and maul are frequently confused. The gavel, the implement of both the Master and Wardens, is an emblem of power by which they use to preserve order in the Lodge, but the maul is a heavy wooden hammer, by which the Mason sets the stone, and in its symbolic state, represents fortitude, that noble and distinct virtue, whereby we are able to overcome any pain, peril or danger when prudently deem expedient.
