

But it also has tangible benefits for the body. For starters, humor frequently triggers laughter, and laughter increases circulation. According to Dr. William Fry, associate clinical professor emeritus of psychiatry at Stanford University School of Medicine, laughing one hundred times a day gives the same boost to the heart and lungs as ten minutes of rowing. It also strengthens the immune system.

Laughing also helps the mind, improving one's sense of well-being by releasing endorphins - natural "feel-good" chemicals - into the bloodstream. When humor triggers laughter, it acts a s a safety valve to relieve tension. It also helps us vent frustration and deal with tragedy. After devastating floods in Minnesota, a store owner erected a sign: Wanted, Waitress. Must be able to do backstroke.

And finally, for many of us, having a sense of humor contributes to our self-esteem. Nobody wants to be told they lack a sense of humor, says Dr. Christopher Peterson, who uses humor in his private practice. Peterson, a professor of psychology at the University of Michigan, reports that "85 percent of Americans claim an above-average sense of humor." Not only that, but "men and women rate a sense of humor among the top four traits they covet in a spouse," which shows the weight they place on it.

The following is a transcript of an actual radio conversation between a British Royal Navy ship and the Canadian authorities of the coast of Newfoundland:

Canada: Please divert your course 15 degrees to the south to avoid a collision

Royal Navy: Recommend you divert your course 15 degrees to the north to avoid collision.
